A Field Day Was Conducted on the Cultivation Techniques of Gundelia as a nonconventional Crop:

A field day on the cultivation techniques of Gundelia was conducted in Tammoun. A group of interested farmers from Buqai'a, Kardalah, and Ein Albeida participated in this activity, along with extensionists from Tubas, Nablus, Jenin and Jericho Directorates. The training aimed to introduce Gundelia cultivation in the Jordan Valley area as a non-conventional crop and to promote the extension methods of transferring expertise and knowledge from farmer to farmer.





Grafted Vegetable seedlings Training in Thinnabeh Cooperative – Tulkarem:

A training on grafted vegetable seedlings in Thinnabeh nursery, within the framework and plans of EVAP project to rehabilitate the nurseries in the production of grafted seedlings. A number of nursery workers participated in this training, to practice the right techniques of vegetable grafting, in addition, holding periodic visits to exchange and transfer the new techniques in the field of grafting.





A Silage Field Day was Conducted in Ein Al Beida:

A Silage field day was conducted in Ein Al Beida – Tubas. The farmers of Ein Albeida, Kardalah and Bardalah Cooperatives participated in the field day in cooperation with EVAP Project. This field day aimed to train the farmers in the targeted areas on Silage making methods to exploit the farm waste and produce inexpensive animal fodders.
